OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill would amend the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 182 to

- (a) delete the references to the word "druggist" in the Act and replace it with the word "pharmacist"; and
- (b) make provision for the duties set out in the Schedule to the Act to be payable in two instalments.

An Act to amend the Liquor Licences Act, Cap. 182.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Liquor Licences (Amendment) Act, Short title. 2009.

Amendment of Cap. 182. 2. The *Liquir Licences Act*, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by deleting the word "druggist" wherever it appears, and substituting the word "pharmacist".

Amendment of section 39 of Cap. 182.

- 3. Section 39 of the principal Act is amended by deleting subsection (1) and substituting the following:
 - "(1) Upon the grant of any application for the issue, renewal or transfer of a licence by a licensing authority or a magistrate, the licensing authority or magistrate, as the case may be, shall issue to the licensee the appropriate licence in respect of
 - (a) a whole year; or
 - (b) a whole year except the first quarter thereof,

upon payment of the appropriate duty set out in the *Schedule*, which shall be paid in two equal instalments.

- (i) the first instalment of which shall be paid, upon the issue of that licence; and
- (ii) the second instalment of which shall be paid, not later than the first day of July in the same year.".
