OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill would amend the *Order of National Heroes Act*, Cap. 399 in order to grant certain benefits to a person upon whom the honour National Hero is conferred.

An Act to amend the Order of National Heroes Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Order of National Heroes Short title. (Amendment) Act, 2009.

Amendment of section 8 of Cap. 399.

2. Section 8 of the *Order of National Heroes Act*, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by deleting the word "Schedule" and substituting the words "First Schedule".

Amendment of section 10 of Cap. 399.

3. The principal Act is amended by deleting section 10 and substituting the following

"The designation, insignia and benefits of the Order of National Hero.

- 10. A person upon whom the honour of National Hero has been conferred shall be
 - (a) referred to as "Right Excellent";
 - (b) entitled to wear as a decoration the prescribed insignia of the Order of National Heroes; and

"Second Schedule. (c) entitled to the benefits set out in the Second Schedule.".

- 4. The principal Act is amended by
- (a) renumbering the Schedule as the "First Schedule"; and

"SECOND SCHEDULE

Benefits To Be Conferred On National Heroes

(Section 10(c))

1. A person upon whom the honour of National Hero is conferred is permitted to import a motor vehicle once every three (3) years free from the payment of duties and taxes.".
