ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Archives (Amendment) Act, 2010. Short title.

Amendment

- 2. Section 3 of the Archives Act, in this Act referred to as the to section 3 of Cap. 19B. principal Act, is amended by inserting the following after subsection (2):
 - "(3) The Minister may by Order amend the Schedule to this Act.". Schedule.

Amendment of the Schedule to Cap. 19B.

3. Paragraph 1 of the Schedule to the principal Act is deleted and the following is substituted:

Constitution of the Committee.

- "1. (1) The Committee shall comprise the following:
 - (a) the Chief Archivist, ex officio;
 - (b) the Solicitor-General, ex officio or his nominee;
 - (c) the Assistant Registrar Archives and Records, of the Cave Hill Campus of the University of the West Indies, ex officio;
 - (d) a public officer other than the person to whom paragraph (b) refers;
 - (e) a member of the academic community; and
 - a member of the public with an interest in the preservation and storage of cultural and historical records.
- (2) The Minister shall by an instrument in writing appoint the members of the Committee.
- (3) The Minister shall appoint a member of the Committee as the Chairman of the Committee.".
