
- (a) any person granted a licence under the Act from the payment of the fees with respect to the grant or renewal of that licence; and

An Act to amend the Telecommunications Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Amendment)* Short title. Act, 2011.

Amendment of section 4 of Cap. 282B.

- 2. Section 4 of the *Telecommunications Act*, in this Act referred to as the principal Act, is amended by inserting the following subsection after subsection (2):
 - "(3) The Minister may by Order exempt any person from the payment of any fee or other payment required to obtain or renew a licence under this Act.".

Insertion of section IIIA into Cap. 282B.

3. The principal Act is amended by inserting the following after section 111.

"Public 111
Officers service exempt from pay ar licence and Act.".

111A. A person who is employed in the public service on a whole time basis shall not be required to pay any fee in respect of the issue of a licence under this Act."
