OBJECTS AND REASONS

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This Bill would validate the collection of sums of money purported to have been collected by the Director of National Insurance in accordance with the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, Cap. 47 that were

- (a) due and payable, as national insurance contributions, for more than 3 years; and
- (b) collected by the Director of National Insurance, by means of a Writ of Summons, an Ordinary Summons or a Claim Form.

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A Bill entitled

An Act to validate the collection of sums of money purported to have been collected by the Director of National Insurance in accordance with the *National Insurance and Social Security Act*, Cap. 47 that were due and payable as national insurance contributions for more than 3 years and were collected by the Director of National Insurance by means of a Writ of Summons, an Ordinary Summons or a Claim Form.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the *National Insurance and Social Security* (Validation) Act, 2014.

Validation

2. The sums of money that were due and payable as national insurance contributions, for more than 3 years and collected by the Director of National Insurance by means of

- (a) a Writ of Summons, from 1st January 2004;
- (b) an Ordinary Summons, from 1st January 2004; and
- (b) a Claim Form, from 1st October, 2009;

to the date of the commencement of the National Insurance and Social Security (Amendment) (No. 2) Act (Act 2013-14), shall be deemed to be validly collected as if the sums of money were collected pursuant to section 43(7) of the National Insurance and Social Security Act, Cap. 47.

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
