OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill would amend the *Technical and Vocational Education and Training Council Act*, Cap. 43 to make better provision in relation to the pension of officers.

An Act to amend the Technical and Vocational Education and Training Council Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Technical and Vocational Short title. Education and Training Council (Amendment) Act, 2006.

Insertion of new section 10A into Cap. 43. 2. The Technical and Vocational Education and Training Council Act is amended by inserting the following new section after section 10:

"Pension where officers are transferred or seconded. Cap. 25.

- 10A. (1) Where a public officer is seconded from a pensionable office within the meaning of the *Pensions Act* to perform any service with the Council, his service with the Council, shall, unless the Governor-General otherwise decides, count for pension under that Act as if the officer had not been so seconded.
 - (2) Where
 - (a) a public officer is transferred to an office in the service of the Council; or
 - (b) an officer of the Council is transferred to an office in the public service,
- Cap. 25. the Pensions Act shall apply to him and,

 his service with the Council shall be treated as other public service under the *Pensions* Act; and

- (ii) the *Pensions Regulations*, 1947 shall apply to him as if the Council were a Scheduled Government within the meaning of regulation 9(1) of those Regulations.
- (3) Where a public officer is transferred to an office in the service of the Council or an officer of the Council is transferred to an office in the public service, the Council shall refund to the Consolidated Fund all moneys payable as pension in respect of the service of that officer with the Council."
