## **BARBADOS**

A Bill entitled

An Act to amend the Copyright Act.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Copyright (Amendment) Short title. Act, 2005.
- 2. Section 101 of the *Copyright Act*, in this Act referred to as Amendment the principal Act, is amended by deleting subsections (2) and (3) of Section 101 of Cap. 300. and substituting the following:

- "(2) The Tribunal shall comprise
- (a) three attorneys-at-law of at least 10 years standing; and
- (b) four other members.
- (3) The members of the Tribunal
- (a) shall be appointed by the Minister for a period of 3 years; and
- (b) shall be eligible for re-appointment.".

Amendment of section 102 of Cap. 300.

- 3. Section 102 of the principal Act is amended by adding the following new subsection after subsection (2):
  - "(3) Where the Tribunal is exercising its jurisdiction
  - (a) under subsection (1)(a), the matter shall be considered by three members of the Tribunal, at least one of whom must be an attorney-at-law who shall be the Chairman of that panel;
  - (b) under subsection (1)(b) or (c), the matter shall be considered by five members of the Tribunal, at least one of whom must be an attorney-at-law who shall be Chairman of that panel.".
