# A Bill entitled

An Act to make provision for the Agreement on Trade, Economic and Technical Co-operation between the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) and the Government of the Republic of Colombia to be given the force of law in Barbados.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade, Economic and Technical Short title. Agreement (Agreement between the Caribbean Community and the Government of the Republic of Colombia) Act, 2005.

Interpretation. 2. In this Act,

# "Agreement" means

(a) the Original Agreement on Trade, Economic and Technical Co-operation between the Caribbean Community and the Government of the Republic of Colombia signed on the 24th day of July, 1994 at Cartagena in Colombia, the text of which is set out in Part I of the Schedule; and

(b) the Protocol that amends the Original Agreement and which was signed on the 21st day of May, 1998 at Georgetown in Guyana, the text of which is set out in Part II of the Schedule.

Schedule.

Agreement to be given force of law in Barbados. Schedule. 3. The Agreement set out in the *Schedule* shall have the force of law in Barbados.

Amendment of Schedule.

4. The Minister may by Order amend the Schedule.
