### **BARBADOS**

### A Bill entitled

An Act to make provision for the Agreement establishing the Free Trade Area between the Caribbean Community and Costa Rica to be given the force of law in Barbados.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Free Trade Area (Agreement Short title establishing the Free Trade Area between the Caribbean Community and the Government of the Republic of Costa Rica) Act, 2005.

Interpretation 2. In this Act,

"Agreement" means the Agreement establishing the Free Trade Area between the Caribbean Community and the Government of the Republic of Costa Rica signed on the 9th day of March, 2004 at Kingston in Jamaica, the text of which is set out in the Schedule.

Schedule.

Agreement to be given the Force of law in Barbados. Schedule. 3. The Agreement set out in the *Schedule* to this Act shall have the force of law in Barbados.

Amendment of Schedule.

4. The Minister may by Order amend the Schedule.
