A Bill entitled

An Act to make provision for the Trade and Economic Co-operation Agreement between the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) and the Government of the Republic of Cuba to be given the force of law in Barbados.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Trade and Economic Co-operation Short title. (Agreement between the Caribbean Community (CARICOM) and the Government of the Republic of Cuba) Act, 2005.

Interpreta-

2. In this Act,

"Agreement" means

(a) the Original Agreement on Trade and Economic Co-operation between the Caribbean Community and the Government of the Republic of Cuba signed on the 5th day of July, 2000 at Canouan in St. Vincent and the Grenadines, the text of which is set out in Part I of the Schedule;

(b) the Protocol that amends the Original Agreement and which was signed on the 15th day of June, 2001 at Kingston in Jamaica, the text of which is set out in Part II of the Schedule; and

(c) the First Additional Protocol that amends the Original Agreement and which was signed on the 15th day of June, 2001 at Kingston in Jamaica, the text of which is set out in Part III of the Schedule.

Agreement to be given force of law in Barbados. Schedule. 3. The Agreement set out in the Schedule shall have the force of law in Barbados.

Amendment of Schedule.

4. The Minister may by Order amend the Schedule.
