WHEREAS the Public Accounts Committee is a Committee of both Houses of Parliament:

WHEREAS Section 7 of the Public Accounts Committee Act 2003-12 authorises either House of Parliament to direct the Public Accounts Committee to inquire into any question connected with the public accounts referred to it by either House:

WHEREAS Hardwood Housing Incorporated is a company in which Enterprise Growth Fund Limited, a company owned by the Crown, controls 90% of the Voting rights in excess of the 50% threshold reflected by the Public Accounts Committee Act 2003-12:

WHEREAS Enterprise Growth Fund Limited and its activities are also subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Accounts Committee: BE IT RESOLVED that this House directs the Public Accounts Committee to inquire immediately into the public accounts and attendant operations of Hardwood Housing Factory Incorporated.
