SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land the property of the Crown situate at Constant in the parish of Saint George in this Island containing by admeasurement 2.76 hectares or thereabouts and abutting and bounding to the north on lands now or formerly of the National Housing Corporation to the east and south on lands now or formerly of Constant Estates Limited and to the west on other lands now or formerly of the Crown or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 16th day of July, 2001 by Harrell G. Gaskin, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 5th day of October, 2001 as Plan No.978/2001.

ADDENDUM

On the 8th day of January, 2009, the Cabinet agreed to the vesting of the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution in the National Housing Corporation for housing development. The Land Aquisition Notice given under section 5 of the *Land Aquisition Act*, Statutory Instrument No. 72 of 2008, declared that the said land was acquired by the Crown for the purpose of housing development.

In accordance with section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution for housing development.
