



**SCHEDULE**

ALL THAT land the property of Kingsland Estates Limited situate at Kendal Hill in the parish of Christ Church in this Island containing by admeasurement 6.380 hectares or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on other lands now or late of the said Kingsland Estates Limited on two sides on a public road known as the Tom Adams Highway and on another public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a Plan certified the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1990 by Nigel S. A. Lucas, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1990 as Plan No. 675/90.

**ADDENDUM**

By Resolution No. 59/1990 Parliament approved the compulsory acquisition of the parcel of land situate at Kendal Hill in the parish of Christ Church in this Island, more particularly described in the Schedule hereto for the purpose of the construction of the Transport Board's Headquarters.

In accordance with Section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap 228 the parcel of land described in the Schedule was vested in the Crown by Statutory Instrument No. 141 of 1990.

The Crown no longer requires the land for the purpose for which it was acquired and the Ministry of Housing and Lands decided to abandon the acquisition of the said parcel of land.

The Cabinet at its meeting held on the 10<sup>th</sup> May, 2012 considered (Note (12) 354/MHL 23 and agreed inter alia to the said abandonment and that the said parcel of land should be returned to its former owner Kingsland Estates Limited.

The approval of Parliament is now being sought for the publication of the notice of abandonment as required by section 9(1) of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228.
