ALL THAT land the property of Eastern Land Development Limited situate at Vaucluse in the parish of Saint Thomas in this Island containing by admeasurement 6.481 hectares or thereabouts abutting and bounding on lands now or formerly of the Barbados Government (Mangrove Landfill) on two sides and of land now or formerly of Vaucluse Estate Ltd. on two sides or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a Plan certified on the 10th day of September, 2009 by Mark Gary Field, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 10th day of September, 2009 as Plan No. 1132/2009.

ADDENDUM

On the 3rd day of June, 2010, the Cabinet agreed to the acquisition of the parcel of land, situate at Vaucluse in the parish of Saint Thomas for the public purpose of expanding the Mangrove Pond Landfill to make more land available for the disposal of waste.

The approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the parcel of land described in the Schedule hereto in order that the purpose set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land.
