## **SCHEDULE**

**ALL THAT** land situate at "Blunts", Airy Cot in the parish Saint Thomas in this Island containing by admeasurement 2199 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 57 metres of road) Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of the Estate of Leotta Medford deceased and on lands now or late of the Estate of Wendell Carrington deceased and on a public road and on lands now or late of the Estate of Edna Gill deceased or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 9th of May, 2000 by Cyril A. Foderingham, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 7th of June 2000 as Plan No. 501/2000.

## ADDENDUM

1. The Cabinet at its meeting on the 7th of August, 1997 agreed that a number of properties owned by the Crown which were categorized as either vacant lots, residual parcels along the Adams Barrow and Cummins Highway or former public baths should now be vested in the National Housing Corporation for sale.

2. The land situate at "Blunts", Saint Thomas more particularly described in the *Schedule* was one of the aforementioned properties so categorized. The said land shall be sold and the proceeds from the sale shall be used to assist the National Housing Corporation in facilitating further housing development.

3. In accordance with the provision of section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225 the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the land described in the *Schedule* to this Resolution.
