ADDENDUM

The *Civil Establishment (Part-Time Officers) Order, 2007* has been laid in Parliament.

2. The Order provides for an increase in the salaries of part-time officers of 7.5% with effect from 1st April, 2006 and an additional increase of 2.5% with effect from 1st April, 2007.

**CIVIL ESTABLISHMENT (PART-TIME OFFICERS)
ORDER, 2007**

The Minister in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 2 of the *Civil Establishment Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Civil Establishment (Part-Time Officers) Order, 2007*.
2. The offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* are established offices. Schedule.
3. (1) Subject to sub-paragraph (2), the Governor-General may appoint to the offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* such part-time officers as he considers necessary. Schedule.
(2) The number of part-time officers appointed under sub-paragraph (1) may not at any time exceed the number specified in the *Schedule*.
4. There are attached to the offices specified in the first column of the *Schedule* the emoluments set out in the second and third columns of the *Schedule* and those emoluments have effect from the dates indicated therein. Schedule
5. Where the emoluments of an established office referred to in this Order are on a scale divided into segments by the symbol ":", an officer holding any such office is not entitled to the emoluments of that scale beyond the point at which the symbol appears except on such conditions as the Governor-General determines in relation to offices of that class.
