## **SCHEDULE**

ALL THAT land (part of a larger area formerly said to contain by admeasurement 2 roods but by recent survey found to contain by admeasurement 2146.61 square metres) situate at Cave Hill, in the parish of Saint Michael, in this Island containing by admeasurement 1577.53 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of A. Williams on lands now or late of E. Bellamy on lands now or late of the National Housing Corporation on lands now or late of A. Cheeseman and on a public road known as Cave Hill Road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 6th day of February, 2006 by Nnaka Forde, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 10th day of February, 2006, as Plan No. 138/2006.

## **ADDENDUM**

On the 25th day of May, 2006, the Cabinet agreed to the vesting of the parcel of land more particularly described in the *Schedule* and situate at Cave Hill, in the parish of Saint Michael, in the National Housing Corporation for residential purposes.

The said parcel of land was acquired by the then Education Board in 1914 by Conveyance from Edith Parris Thorne *et al.* The said Conveyance dated the 26th day of November, 1914, was recorded in the Registration Office on the 5th day of December, 1914 in Volume 448, folio 483.

This parcel of land became the site of the former Edghill Memorial Skills

Training Centre and was occupied by the Barbados Vocational Training Board
until 1995 when the building was destroyed by fire.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands* (*Vesting and Disposal*) *Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the National Housing Corporation of the parcel of land described in the *Schedule* to this Resolution.
