PARLIAMENT

RESOLVED that Parliament in accordance with section 5 of the Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act, Cap. 225 approve the vesting in Bush Hill Tourism Trust Inc., a non-profit company incorporated under the Companies Act, Cap. 308, of the parcel of land the property of the Crown, situate at Bush Hill, the Garrison in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island more particularly described in the Schedule to this Resolution to facilitate its restoration and preservation as a heritage tourism site.

SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land situate at Bush Hill, the Garrison in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 7,245 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 55 square metres in sidewalk) Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of the Barbados Mutual Life Assurance Society on lands now or late of Barbados Bottling Company Limited on lands now or late of John and Angela Cropper on lands now or late of the Royal Bank of Canada and on the public road known as Bush Hill or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 15th day of December, 1998 by Cyril A. Foderingham, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 28th day of December, 1998 as Plan No. 1031/98 together with the buildings thereon.

ADDENDUM

The Cabinet at its meeting on the 25th day of June, 1998 agreed that the property situate at Bush Hill, the Garrison in the parish of Saint Michael more particularly described in the Schedule hereto, should be acquired and vested in the Barbados National Trust to facilitate its restoration and preservation as a heritage tourism site. The said property was acquired on the 13th day of September 1999 by S.I. 1999 No. 77.

The Cabinet at another meeting held on the 10th day of March 2005 agreed to rescind its decision of the 25th day of June 1998 and further agreed that the said property be vested in Bush Hill Tourism Trust Inc., a company incorporated under the *Companies Act*, as a non-profit company, in order to facilitate the restoration of the property as a heritage tourism site.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands* (*Vesting and Disposal*) *Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the Bush Hill Tourism Trust Inc. of the parcel of land described in the Schedule to this Resolution.
