FIRST SCHEDULE

FIRSTLY ALL THAT land the property of Plantrac Engineering Limited situate at Eagle Hall in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 51.9 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on other lands now or late of the said Plantrac Engineering Limited and on the public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 17th day of July, 2000 by James W. Abrahams, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 26th day of October, 2000 as Plan No. 968/2000 and **SECONDLY ALL THAT** land the property of the said Plantrac Engineering Limited situate at Eagle Hall in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 66.2 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 16.9 square meters in road) Abutting and Bounding on a road called Bosvigo Gap on other lands now or late of Plantrac Engineering Limited and on the public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 17th day of July, 2000 by James W. Abrahams, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 26th day of October, 2000 as Plan No. 968/2000.

SECOND SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land the property of East Caribbean Conference of Seventh Day Adventists situate at Dalkeith Road in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 212.86 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on other lands now or late of the said Caribbean Conference of Seventh Day Adventists and on the public road or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated on a plan certified on the 3rd day of March, 2000 by James W. Abrahams, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 26th day of October, 2000 as Plan No. 966/2000.

ADDENDUM

On the 9th day of November, 2000 the Cabinet agreed that the parcels of land situate in the parish of Saint Michael described in the Schedules to this Resolution should be acquired for the purpose of facilitating construction work on the Bridgetown Roads and Safety Improvement Project.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228 the approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the parcels of land described in the Schedules in order that the purposes set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcels of land.
