SCHEDULE

ALL THAT land the property of Vida Blackman situate at Ashby Avenue No. 3, Oistins in the parish of Christ Church in this Island containing by admeasurement 13.7 square metres or thereabouts Abutting and Bounding on lands now or late of the said Vida Blackman being Lot 2A1 on lands now or late of the Crown on two sides and on a road known as Ashby Avenue No. 3 measuring 4.90 metres wide leading to a cul-de-sac in one direction and to Highway 7 in the other direction or however else the same may abut and bound as shown and delineated as the plot bordered green on a plan certified on the 25th day of March, 2004 by Andre P. G. Clarke, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 8th day of April, 2004 as Plan No. 395/2004.

ADDENDUM

On the 25th November, 1999 the Cabinet agreed to the purchase of the parcel of land situate at Ashby Avenue No.3, Oistins in the parish of Christ Church more particulary described in the Schedule to the Resolution for the development of an access road to Crown land at Lot 3, Barnett Land, Welches, Oistins, Christ Church.

The approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the said parcel of land in order that the purpose set out in the Resolution may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land.
