ADDENDUM

The Cabinet at its meeting held on the 31th July, 2003 agreed that a parcel of land situate at Flint Hall in the Parish of Saint Michael the property of Sir Stanley Blanchette should be compulsorily acquired for the construction of the Erdiston/Carrington Primary School.

The approval of Parliament is now sought for the compulsory acquisition of the said land containing by admeasurement 906.20 square metres or thereabouts as described in the schedule to the Resolution in order that the purpose set out therein may be effected and that the Crown may acquire an indefeasible title to the said parcel of land.
