**SCHEDULE**

**ALL THAT** land the property of the Crown situate at Bay Street in the parish of Saint Michael in this Island containing by admeasurement 7328.3 square metres or thereabouts (inclusive of 158.4 square metres in road and 3831.3 square metres in beach) Abutting and Bounding on lands now or formerly of Vision Developments Inc. on the sea on lands now or formerly of M. G. Tucker and Co. Ltd. on a public road known as Bay Street leading to Chamberlain Bridge in one direction and to Wellington Street in the other direction or however else the same may abut and bound together with the buildings thereon, as shown and delineated on a Plan certified on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2019 by Anderson R. Alleyne, Land Surveyor and recorded in the Lands and Surveys Department on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 2019 as Plan No. 575/2019.

**ADDENDUM**

The Cabinet at its meeting held on the 18<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019 agreed to the vesting of 7328.3 square metres of land the property of the Crown situate at Bay Street in the parish of Saint Michael in the Barbados Tourism Investment Inc.

On the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 2019 the property situated at Bay Street in the parish of Saint Michael became acquired by the Crown in accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Land Acquisition Act*, Cap. 228.

In accordance with the provisions of section 5 of the *Crown Lands (Vesting and Disposal) Act*, Cap. 225, the approval of Parliament is now sought for the vesting in the Barbados Tourism Investment Inc. of the parcel of land more particularly described in the *Schedule* to this Resolution.
