## ADDENDUM

This Resolution seeks to revise the rate of the salary and travelling allowance applicable to the post of Personal Assistant to a Minister.

The revision results in an increase of 3% in the salary for the financial year 2023 to 2024 and a corresponding cumulative increase of 3% in the salary for the financial year 2024 to 2025.

The revision also results in an increase of 10% in the travelling allowance for the financial year 2022 to 2023, an increase of 3% in the travelling allowance for the financial year 2023 to 2024 and a corresponding increase of 3% in the travelling allowance for the financial year 2024 to 2025.

These increases are commensurate with the increases granted to public officers.

It is proposed that the salary and travelling allowance applicable to the post of Personal Assistant to a Minister be revised as set out in the *Schedule* to the Resolution.
